Objectives

Brief Description

We invited parents and their children to join us at the school hall of Aberdeen Kaifong Welfare Association Services Centre. To kick off the event, children from each class took the stage to recite classic Tang Dynasty poems. Following the poetry recitations, our staff members transformed into ancient characters to lead a series of traditional sports and games such as cuju (a form of ancient football), drumming, arrow pitching, fifteen-pin bowling, and ball striking. By participating in these activities, families not only enjoyed quality time together but also gained a deeper appreciation for ancient sports, fostering a sense of cultural pride and national identity.
